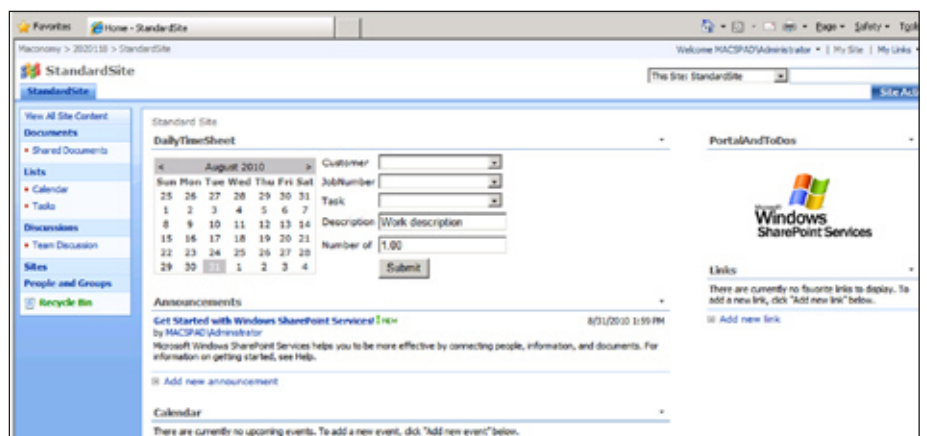
2 ways to integrate

Web Parts

Maconomy has developed a number of Web Parts that can be easily integrated into SharePoint by the user. These Web Parts allow users to register time, create projects and run business reports, among other things.

iFrame

Using an iFrame, Maconomy can build an HTML-based SharePoint portal with full integration to the Maconomy database. This enables more in-depth functionality, for instance a weekly time sheet. Since iFrame-based Web Parts depend on Single Sign-On, they are best suited for an intranet.

Real-time synchronization

When Maconomy is integrated to Microsoft SharePoint, all data is transferred quickly and discreetly between the Maconomy server and the SharePoint server. Data entered in SharePoint is synchronized with the Maconomy server and vice versa. The user will not notice any synchronization delay.

Preconfigured by Maconomy

Maconomy is able to deliver out-of-the-box Web Parts and iFrames for any SharePoint environment. These preconfigured components can be easily added to an existing SharePoint environment.
